Logan City Council - CEO SACKING Response From The Services Union

The Services Union which represents employees at Logan City Council is bewildered by the sacking of Chief Executive Officer (CEO) Sharon Kelsey today.

Ms Kelsey has what looks like an impeccable resume that boasts the Executive Director position at Victoria's Independent Broad-based Anti-Corruption Commission (IBAC) as well as senior Local Government experience so the sacking sets off alarm bells.

Secretary of The Services Union Neil Henderson said it is not a good look for Logan City Council who is currently being investigated by the Queensland Crime and Commission (CCC).

"At a time where there have been more Councillors accused of misbehaviour and many senior officials in trouble at other Councils in Queensland, the sacking really does make you wonder what is going on," Mr Henderson said.

"Our members are hard-working people who strive each and every day to deliver services to the Logan community."

"What they need and what the community expects from their elected officials is stability and good governance."

"This sends a shocking message to all employees at Logan City Council about job security and fair treatment."
