Logan City Council - Work Stoppages Friday, 27 July 2018

It has finally become all too much for Logan City Council management.

The Council is presently in bargaining with its workforce, but the signs are there that there have been too many distractions.

The Council has been offering its workforce a pay deal which would see the largely female occupied administrative and clerical pay levels receive less than half of the ongoing wage rise the male workforce would receive.

Not surprisingly The Services Union which represents these workers has roundly condemned the offer as contributing to the gender pay gap and rejected it.

Undaunted the Council has embarked on a campaign to '....celebrate the women working at Logan', and achieve '...equitable working conditions for all'!

Only in Logan you ask?

The Services Union and other unions have notified further work stoppages for this Friday, 27 July 2018.

Secretary of The Services Union Neil Henderson said, "Logan City Council is now drifting and its management has lost its way."

"We will never agree to an agreement that includes a two tiered workforce and I will certainly never sign off on one that means less money in the pay packets of female workers."
